ABOUT YOUR PRESENTATION

Free Paper Competition

1. Presentation Length

The allocated time for the presentation is a maximum of **5 (five) minutes**, following by **3 (three) minutes** Q&A session with the judges. The presentation will be strictly timed by the committee and the judges will ask the presenter to stop talking when the time is up. Please ensure that your presentation does not go over your allocated time. The presentation and Q&A session will be held in English.

2. Presentation Format

- a. The aspect ratio of the PowerPoint presentation should be **16:9** (Please use the provided presentation slide template)
- b. Presenters must prepare presentation slides in English
- c. Presenters **are not allowed** to include any institution or affiliation name and logo in the presentation slides.
- d. Please prepare your presentation slides (.ppt or .pptx) and upload the file to https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/13gn-vn1fFnGdknPQ0V0jpHovtOCUzP7N?usp=sharing by Sunday, 31th August 11.59 PM. Your presentations will be checked for technical aspects prior to arriving onsite.

E-poster Competition

1. Presentation Length

The allocated time for the presentation is a maximum of **3 (Three) minutes**. There will be **Q&A session** with the judges for **2 (two) minutes**. The presentation will be strictly timed by the committee

and the judges will ask the presenter to stop talking when the time is up. Please ensure that your presentation does not go over your allocated time. The presentation will be held in English.

2. Presentation Format

- a. It is **not necessary to prepare presentation slides** as presenters will **present directly** from the e-poster.
- b. Presenters **are not allowed** to include any institution or affiliation name and logo in the e-poster.
